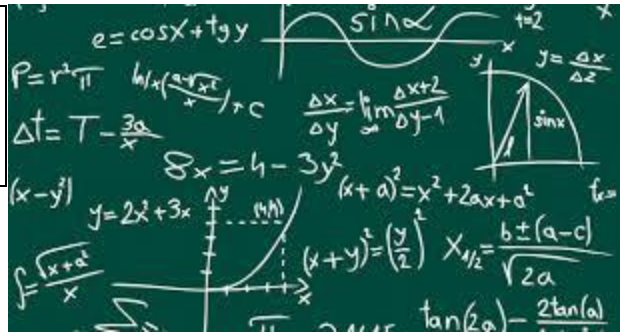


Honors PreCalc Policies

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Some topics we will study are functions (polynomial, trigonometric, exponential, and logarithmic), sequences and series, rational roots, conic sections, polar and parametric equations, and limits and derivatives. You have studied many of these topics in the past, but we are going to study them at a greater depth than in previous classes.

Organizing Your Digital Work

In school I would normally pass out worksheets and students would store them in a binder or folder. Since we are in a virtual setting, I want you to know how to organize your work virtually so that you can refer back to things that we do in class.

Lessons in class will mainly take one of two forms: Desmos activities and digital worksheets. Desmos activities will be stored on your account when you sign in.

You must create an account for the following websites. Use your full name when you make the account.

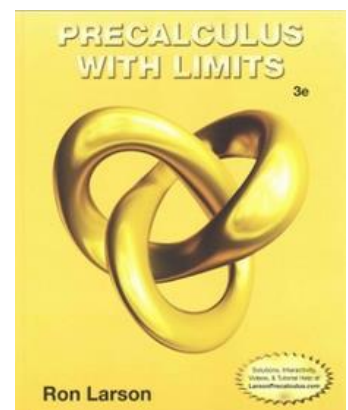
